

## Deadline for submission to MEDEA Awards 1 December 2016

The aim of this annual competition now entering its ninth year, is to encourage innovation and good practice in the use of media (audio, video, graphics and animation) in education. The MEDEA Awards also recognise and promote excellence in the production and pedagogical design of media-rich learning resources. Finalists will be invited to take part in the Media & Learning Conference taking place in Brussels on 6-7 April 2017 during which the MEDEA Awards Ceremony will take place.

This awards scheme continues to grow in recognition and quality – in 2016 the competition attracted almost 300 entries from 30 countries.

The competition offers two main awards:

- The MEDEA Award for User-Generated Educational Media
- The MEDEA Award for Professionally Produced Educational Media

In certain circumstances the jury may also decide to award one or more special jury prizes.



The deadline to submit your entry is 1 December 2016. Submission forms are available in English, French, German, Italian, Polish and Spanish and need to be completed in one of these languages but the educational media submitted can be in any language.
